PHS Year in Review

- Committed to creating monthly "Then & Now" documents to maintain communication with our PHS Membership & Friends via email. Twenty emailed issues thus far.
- Committed to creating an initial 8 "Can You Find It" Locations. This historical
 problem-solving outdoor activity provides a summer scavenger hunt for families
 and small groups. Over 100 copies of the gamecard were downloaded last
 summer, so we will continue to provide 8 new locations for the next few
 summers.
- Began offering Historical Programs via Zoom.
- Converted our previous historical collection database from "Past Perfect" to "Catalogit" an online service provider.
- Built a bookcase to better organize the Woodward Room.
- Built a storage rack to better organize the Mason Room at Post Office Place
